WHEREAS, Mr. Karpan married the former Janet Claire Mevis on December 30, 1950, and the couple shared 56 years together, including more than two decades in Florida, where they lived their retirement to the fullest, golfing, attending cultural events, and spending time with dear friends; Mr. Karpan was especially proud of his golf record, which included hitting four holes in one, and he continued to enjoy a passion for photography; and

WHEREAS, A beloved husband, father, and grandfather, Matt Karpan inspired countless individuals with his enthusiasm, dedication, and verve, and although he will be greatly missed, he leaves behind a legacy that will be treasured by those who shared in his life; now, therefore, be it
