WHEREAS, Situated on some 600 square miles of Gulf Coast plains, Chambers County was settled by the Spaniards, the French, the Mexicans, and numerous Native American tribes before being officially created in 1858 from portions of Liberty and Jefferson Counties; it is named for T. J. Chambers, who served as chief justice of the Supreme Court of Coahuila and Texas and as surveyor general; and

WHEREAS, Countless tourists enjoy the many attractions and festivals offered by Chambers County; Anahuac, designated as the Alligator Capital of Texas, hosts the Texas Gatorfest each September at Fort Anahuac Park, and a few weeks later, Winnie hosts the Texas Rice Festival, celebrating the annual rice harvest; and

WHEREAS, Visitors are also drawn to the area for recreational opportunities, including birding, fishing, hunting, crabbing, boating, camping, and golfing; in particular, Chambers County is home to the Anahuac National Wildlife Refuge, where more than 270 species of birds can be seen, and the Candy Cain Abshier Wildlife Management Area, 207 acres along Galveston Bay and Trinity Bay in which numerous birds congregate on their way to and from South
