WHEREAS, Ordained in June 1957, Father Davis studied philosophy and theology at DeMazenod Scholasticate in San Antonio and earned a master's degree in social studies from Loyola Marymount University in Los Angeles; he furthered his education by attending the Tantur Ecumenical Institute for Theological Studies in Israel; and

WHEREAS, Father Davis had his first assignment professor, teaching at La Purissima Juniorate in Mexico City from 1958 to 1960, and he followed that position with several decades of service as a professor, pastor, program director, and campus minister in San Antonio, with a two-year period as spiritual director for oblate students at Creighton University; and

WHEREAS, The year 1990 brought with it great change for Father Davis as he left his position as pastor of St. Mary's Catholic Church in San Antonio to go to Africa to assist in mission work; for the next three years, he was associate director of the Pre-Novitiate Formation Program in Lusaka, Zambia, before he returned to the States; he most recently has been pastor of Immaculate Heart of Mary Church in Houston; and
