1 WHEREAS, The friends and family of U.S. Army Corporal Timothy 2 Allen Swanson of San Antonio suffered an immeasurable loss with the 3 death of this valiant soldier on January 27, 2007, at the age of 21; 4 and

5 WHEREAS, Assigned to the 2nd Battalion, 8th Cavalry Regiment, 6 1st Brigade, 1st Cavalry Division at Fort Hood, Corporal Swanson 7 was mortally wounded when a roadside bomb struck his convoy in Taji, 8 Iraq; and

WHEREAS, Born on March 25, 1985, in Fort Hood, Tim Swanson 9 graduated in 2003 from Clark High School, where he was a member of 10 11 R.O.T.C.; eager to serve his country, he joined the Army and was 12 subsequently posted to Fort Carson, Colorado; he served as an M-1 13 tank crewman during his first tour of Iraq, earning the Global War 14 on Terrorism Service Medal and the Army Service Ribbon, and did not hesitate to sign on for a second tour, for which he served as a 15 16 member of a personal security detail; he was posthumously awarded the Purple Heart, Bronze Star with valor, and Army Good Conduct 17 18 Medal; and

WHEREAS, Corporal Swanson was an enthusiastic outdoorsman who often spent his free time fishing, hiking, or hunting and also enjoyed paintball and martial arts; devoted to his family and friends, he especially cherished visits with his grandparents in Texas and Wisconsin; he was rarely seen without a smile, and he delighted others with his indomitable sense of humor; and
