RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, The celebration of Angelina County Days at the State 2 Capitol on February 21 and 22, 2007, provides a fitting opportunity 3 to recognize this notable part of the Lone Star State and to welcome visitors from the county, including the members of the Lufkin 4 5 Leadership Class of 2007; and WHEREAS, The lush forests and rolling hills of Angelina 6 County were once home to the Caddo and Atakapa peoples, and legend 7 has it that the county was named for a Hainai Indian woman who aided 8 Spanish missionaries in East Texas in the late 1600s; the first 9 Anglo settlers arrived in 1820, settling near present-day Lufkin; 10 the county was organized in 1846 and grew quickly as newcomers were 11 12 attracted by ample farming and grazing land and by ready access to 13 the Angelina and Neches Rivers; and 14 WHEREAS, Between these two rivers lay vast tracts of timber, and with the arrival of the railroads in the 1880s, the lumber trade 15 became paramount to the life of Angelina County and continues to 16 employ many residents; the county further enjoys the prosperity 17 brought by such businesses as the manufacturing of oil-field 18 equipment, truck trailers, and mobile homes; the farms and ranches 19 of the county are likewise important, producing poultry, beef, 20 21 melons, peaches, and pecans; and 22 WHEREAS, A favorite destination for campers, hikers, 23 naturalists, and hunters, the Angelina National Forest offers some
