WHEREAS, Born August 22, 1983, Walker Best grew up in San 5 Antonio and attended Winston Churchill High School, where he was a 6 wide receiver for the Chargers football team and impressed his 7 teammates and coaches with his hard work and spirited play; he was 8 equally dedicated to his studies, and his exceptional grades earned 9 him the title of valedictorian for the 2002 graduating class; he was 10 11 also active in student government, and his accomplishments as 12 athlete, scholar, and leader prompted his classmates to vote him the best all-around student at Churchill High; and 13

14 WHEREAS, After receiving his diploma, Mr. Best enrolled at Texas A&M University in the fall of 2002, where he majored in 15 biology and was an honors student; though focused on academics, he 16 found time to participate in extracurricular affairs at the 17 university, acting as chair for intramural league activities, being 18 voted Sportsman of the Year for 2004-2005, and serving as a member 19 of the Conference on Student Government Associations; his ultimate 20 21 goal was to become a doctor, like his father before him, and he planned to attend medical school after his anticipated graduation 22 23 in December 2006; and
