1           WHEREAS, The Prince Complex, Incorporated, in Houston is  
2 recognizing five outstanding honorees at its 2007 Gala, "A Knockout  
3 Affair," on March 1, 2007; and

4           WHEREAS, Since its inception in 1998, the nonprofit  
5 organization has offered athletic, recreational, and academic  
6 programs to thousands of disadvantaged youths in Houston, and this  
7 annual fund-raiser seeks to heighten awareness of this important  
8 facility and the services it provides in the community; and

9           WHEREAS, Bernard Hopkins is one of the individuals being  
10 honored at the 2007 gala; the current light heavyweight champion of  
11 the world, Mr. Hopkins made his name as the premier middleweight  
12 fighter of his generation; nicknamed "The Executioner," this  
13 hall-of-famer first claimed the middleweight crown in 1995, and he  
14 went on to defend his title in 20 consecutive bouts; and

15           WHEREAS, Raised in Philadelphia, Mr. Hopkins has become a  
16 role model for legions of fans in his hometown and beyond; he  
17 supports and participates in numerous charitable endeavors, most  
18 notably the Bernard and Shirley Hopkins Make a Way Foundation,  
19 which funds programs promoting safe and healthy activities for  
20 children; and

21           WHEREAS, The 2007 honorees have demonstrated an unwavering  
22 dedication to excellence in their respective fields of expertise  
23 while maintaining a steadfast commitment to helping others, and the  
24 receipt of this award brings well-deserved recognition to their
