R E S O L U T I O N

2 too soon, and it is with great sadness that we join the family and
3 friends of Christopher Aaron Pichon II of Houston in mourning his
4 passing on September 18, 2006, at the age of 14; and

5 WHEREAS, Born on December 8, 1991, Mr. Pichon was a sophomore
6 in the Engineering Program at Booker T. Washington High School and
7 was a member of the National Junior Honor Society and the junior
8 varsity football team; in addition, he was a valued parishioner of
9 St. Francis Xavier Catholic Church, and he gave of his time and
10 talents as a member of the Altar Servers, the Ambassadors of Christ,
11 the People to People Student Ambassador Program, and the Jr.
12 Knights of Saint Peter Claver (KPC); and

13 WHEREAS, Mr. Pichon's involvement with the KPC included
14 service as the recording secretary, inner/outer guard,
15 parliamentarian, and treasurer of his local chapter; he officiated
16 as treasurer and president of the state organization, and in these
17 pivotal roles, he inspired countless individuals with his
18 leadership and was instrumental in the success of a number of
19 projects benefiting those in need; and

20 WHEREAS, The tragic passing of Mr. Pichon has ended a life
21 filled with promise, but his loved ones may take a measure of
22 comfort in knowing that his accomplishments, his love and
23 friendship, and his service to others will not be forgotten; now,
