

R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, The retirement of Robert Cliff Price as Coryell  
2 County Commissioner, Precinct 2, in 2006, brought to a close an  
3 outstanding tenure of public service; and

4           WHEREAS, Elected county commissioner in 1998, Mr. Price  
5 counted among his many responsibilities helping to set the budget  
6 for all county departments and to decide yearly property tax rates;  
7 calling, conducting, and certifying elections; and setting  
8 precinct boundaries; and

9           WHEREAS, A sixth-generation Texan and descendent of the Asa  
10 Langford family, Mr. Price was born in the Blue Ridge community of  
11 Hamilton County; he began to work at the age of 15, finding  
12 employment with an oil refinery, an oil rig, and a lumberyard; he  
13 served for three years with the air force, before being honorably  
14 discharged in 1949; and

15           WHEREAS, Mr. Price enjoyed a 30-year tenure with General  
16 Electric, retiring as region manager of product services in Houston  
17 in 1983; he owned his own management consulting firm in Gatesville  
18 for 15 years and, from 1993 to 1997, served as Coryell County  
19 Republican Chair; and

20           WHEREAS, An active member of his community, Mr. Price serves  
21 as an elder at First Presbyterian Church and is a valued member of  
22 the Coryell County Historical Commission and the Coryell County  
23 Genealogical Society; and

24           WHEREAS, Through his dedication and commitment, Robert Price

1 has gained the respect and appreciation of countless citizens in  
2 Coryell County, and he may take justifiable pride in the legacy of  
3 achievement he leaves behind; now, therefore, be it

4       RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 80th Texas  
5 Legislature hereby honor Robert Cliff Price on his notable public  
6 service and extend to him best wishes for a rewarding retirement;  
7 and, be it further

8       RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be  
9 prepared for Mr. Price as an expression of high regard by the Texas  
10 House of Representatives.
