2 District men's athletic director and head football coach, has been  
3 named the recipient of the Bayard H. Friedman Hummer Hero Award as  
4 the "Outstanding School Coach in Texas"; and

5           WHEREAS, Given by Score A Goal in the Classroom and the Dallas  
6 Cowboys organization, the Bayard H. Friedman Hummer Hero Award is

17 Allen has carried on the example of excellence once set by Bayard H.  
18 Friedman, and he may indeed reflect with pride on his many
