1           WHEREAS, Lieutenant Colonel William Brock of Dallas was  
2 awarded the Army Commendation Medal with Valor device for his  
3 crucial role in the life-saving surgery of a wounded soldier in  
4 March 2006; and

5           WHEREAS, Stationed at Camp Aned on the border between  
6 Afghanistan and Pakistan, Lieutenant Colonel Brock served as a  
7 member of the 759th Medical Detachment, Forward Surgical Team  
8 (Airborne), Task Force Med; although every day brought its unique  
9 challenges, this day he was called on to perform an exceptionally  
10 dangerous task, when an unexploded rocket-propelled grenade was  
11 discovered in the stomach of a new patient; before Major John Oh,  
12 general surgeon, could perform surgery, the patient required  
13 intubation to receive necessary fluids, and this duty was assigned  
14 to Lieutenant Colonel Brock; wearing a body armor vest and a  
15 ballistic helmet over his scrubs, he successfully performed the  
16 operation, paving the way for the X-ray procedure and surgery that  
17 followed; and

18           WHEREAS, Lieutenant Colonel Brock responded to a critical  
19 medical event with bravery, skill, and selfless dedication, and his  
20 actions are deserving of our deepest respect; now, therefore, be it

21           RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 80th Texas  
22 Legislature hereby commend Lieutenant Colonel William Brock for his  
23 significant contribution to the life-saving surgery of a wounded  
24 soldier and congratulate him on his receipt of the Army
