

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Words cannot express the heartache felt at the loss
2 of U.S. Marine Lance Corporal Julio C. Cisneros-Alvarez of Pharr,
3 who died in Iraq on January 6, 2005, at the age of 22; and

4 WHEREAS, Although he was mortally injured in an ambush in Al
5 Anbar Province, Lance Corporal Cisneros-Alvarez acted in behalf of
6 four fellow Marines, who were also wounded in the blast, and they
7 credit his heroism for their survival; and

8 WHEREAS, Lance Corporal Cisneros-Alvarez joined the military
9 in the hopes of one day becoming a doctor; an ambitious and diligent
10 young man, he trained in a variety of roles, including drill
11 instructor, machine gunner, assault man, and nurse's assistant; and

12 WHEREAS, Our state and nation are fortunate to have young men
13 and women whose love of country leads them to military duty, and
14 time can never diminish the profound debt that Americans owe to
15 Julio Cisneros-Alvarez for the service he undertook and the
16 sacrifice he rendered; the thoughts and prayers of many go out to
17 the family of this beloved young man; he was a soldier of honor and
18 valor, and those who were fortunate to share in the blessing of his
19 life will forever carry him close in their hearts; now, therefore,
20 be it

21 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 80th Texas
22 Legislature hereby honor the memory of Lance Corporal Julio C.
23 Cisneros-Alvarez and extend sincere sympathy to all those who mourn
24 his passing; and, be it further
