R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, David and Susan Kleven of Animal Edutainment, Inc.,
2 of Aubrey, on behalf of Wild Wonders, Inc., of California and in
3 association with the Animal Planet cable network, are presenting
4 animals from around the world on the grounds of the State Capitol on
5 February 21, 2007, to the delight of all those in attendance; and

6 WHEREAS, Founded by the Klevens in 1990 and named as "Best
7 Traveling Zoo" in *D Magazine's* Best of Dallas issue in 2003, Animal
8 Edutainment introduces wildlife to the public through "safaris" at
9 school assemblies, libraries, corporate events, and other venues
10 all over North Texas and beyond; the organization's animal care
11 facility is home to over 50 orphaned, injured, or cast-off animals;

13 WHEREAS, David Kleven, also known as "Critterman" to his many
14 young fans, trained at America's Teaching Zoo at Moorpark College
15 in California; he has worked with animals at the Los Angeles and San
16 Diego Zoos and at Universal Studios and has also appeared in
17 segments of the Animal Planet series *The Most Extreme*; and

18 WHEREAS, Texas native Susan Kleven, also known as "Safari
19 Sue," graduated from Pearce High School in Richardson and attended
20 the University of North Texas; she trained as well at America's
21 Teaching Zoo and has also appeared with her husband on Animal
22 Planet; the president of the Association of Professional Wildlife
23 Educators, she is also director of the Frank Buck Zoo in
24 Gainesville, which is named after the famous explorer and

1 Gainesville native, Frank "Bring 'Em Back Alive" Buck; and

2 WHEREAS, In their appearance today on the grounds of the
3 State Capitol, David and Susan Kleven are presenting animals on
4 behalf of Wild Wonders, Inc., of California that hail from
5 throughout the world; these include an American alligator, a
6 beaver, a ring-tail lemur, a turkey vulture, and a great horned owl;
