1 WHEREAS, Betty Lee Moor MacGuire was inducted into the El  
2 Paso Commission for Women Hall of Fame on March 9, 2007; and

3 WHEREAS, Established in 1985, the commission is composed of  
4 El Paso citizens who are committed to the pursuit of equal rights  
5 and responsibilities for all women; inductees to the organization's  
6 Hall of Fame are recognized in one of five categories, including  
7 arts, education, civic leadership, professional, and public  
8 service; and

9 WHEREAS, Selected for the civic leadership category, Ms.  
10 MacGuire has shared her time with a number of community groups,  
11 including the YWCA, the El Paso Community Foundation, the Salvation  
12 Army, and Planned Parenthood; in addition, she has served as  
13 president of the board of directors of the Lee and Beulah Moor  
14 Children's Home for nearly a half-century and helped to establish  
15 endowed chairs in The University of Texas at El Paso accounting and  
16 engineering departments; and

17 WHEREAS, The strength of our communities and the vitality of  
18 the State of Texas depend on the dedication of women like Betty  
19 MacGuire; she uses her considerable talents and generous spirit to  
20 serve others, and it is a pleasure to join the commission in  
21 honoring her; now, therefore, be it
