1 WHEREAS, Mary S. Young was inducted into the El Paso
2 Commission for Women Hall of Fame on March 9, 2007; and

3 WHEREAS, Established in 1985, the commission is composed of
4 El Paso citizens who are committed to the pursuit of equal rights
5 and responsibilities for all women; inductees to the organization's
6 Hall of Fame are recognized in one of five categories, including
7 arts, education, civic leadership, professional, and public
8 service; and

9 WHEREAS, Selected for the education category, Ms. Young has
10 dedicated 36 years to the David L. Carrasco Job Corps Center, which
11 works to prepare economically disadvantaged young men and women for
12 productive careers and helps give troubled young adults a second
13 chance; and

15 the State of Texas depend on the dedication of women like Mary
16 Young; she uses her considerable talents and generous spirit to
17 serve others, and it is a pleasure to join the commission in
18 honoring her; now, therefore, be it
