3 of time spent in his company; and

4           WHEREAS, Dr. Brecht earned his bachelor's degree from  
5 Southwestern University in Georgetown in 1960 and his doctorate in  
6 dental surgery from the Baylor University College of Dentistry in  
7 Dallas in 1965; he served in the U.S. Navy as a dental officer,  
8 stationed primarily at Parris Island and Guam, and retired from the  
9 Naval Reserve as a commander; and

10           WHEREAS, A valued member of the Seguin community, Dr. Brecht  
11 worked as a dentist for 42 years; he also served on the boards of  
12 MHMR, Head Start, the Seguin Independent School District, and the  
13 Texas Agricultural Education and Heritage Center; and

14           WHEREAS, Along with his wife, the late Marlys Brecht, Jon  
15 Brecht raised two children and with the passing years was blessed  
16 with the joys of dotting on three grandchildren; and

17           WHEREAS, In his leisure time, he indulged his passion for  
18 classic cars and Harley-Davidsons and in recent years had enjoyed  
19 many cross-country motorcycle rides; and

20           WHEREAS, A dedicated professional, a caring husband and  
21 father, and an engaged citizen, Dr. Brecht excelled in each of these  
22 roles, and his life serves as an inspiration to those who were  
23 fortunate enough to share in his love and friendship; now,  
24 therefore, be it

1           RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 80th Texas  
2 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life of Jon Howard Brecht and  
3 extend sincere sympathy to the members of his family: to his  
4 daughter and son-in-law, Stacey and Quint Alexander; to his son,

6 brother, Bill Brecht, and his wife, Jennifer; and to his other
