15 interest in art and photography as a young girl; she attended The
16 University of Texas at Austin, where she studied with renowned
17 photographer Russell Lee; and

19 for the Blind and Visually Impaired; while at the school, she
20 founded the "Vision Quest" program, an innovative project that
21 offered students photography instruction and helped improve their
22 vision; and
