1 WHEREAS, Since its inception in 2003, Impact Austin has made
2 invaluable contributions to the community it serves, and its
3 members merit special recognition for their outstanding service;
4 and

5 WHEREAS, This nonprofit organization is composed of 416
6 women who are dedicated to upholding the organization's mission of
7 making a difference in the Austin area through high-impact and
8 lifelong giving; and

9 WHEREAS, Each year, the members of Impact Austin fund grants
10 that are then awarded to selected programs and projects of benefit
11 to the community; as of 2006, these exceptional Texans have raised
12 more than \$650,000, which has gone on to assist Austin Travis County
13 Mental Health Mental Retardation Center, LifeWorks, The Children's
14 Wellness Center, EmanciPet, Inc., Communities In Schools, and
15 Literacy Austin; they plan on donating more than \$400,000 for their
16 2007 grants, bringing their total amount of money given to over \$1
17 million; and
