WHEREAS, A five-time NBA All-Star and nine-time selection to the NBA's All-Defensive team, Mr. Johnson retired in 1990 as only the 11th player in NBA history to record more than 15,000 points and 5,000 assists; and

his teams to the playoffs 13 times; he guided the Seattle
Supersonics to the NBA Championship in 1979, earning Finals MVP
honors, and he won titles with Boston in 1984 and 1986; in 1991, he
joined an elite group of players when the Boston Celtics
organization retired his No. 3 jersey, a tribute reserved for a
special class and caliber of player; and
