14 commissioner of Clark County, Nevada, and was the first woman to  
15 serve on the city council in Las Vegas; and

16           WHEREAS, This former Miss Oregon has been honored with a host  
17 of accolades, including the Woman of Achievement award from the  
18 Notre Dame Alumni Association and the Community Hero award from the  
19 National Conference of Christians and Jews; in addition, her  
20 advocacy for affordable housing earned her recognition from the  
21 Southern Nevada Home Builders Association; and

23 privileged to know her, and she truly merits special commendation
