1           WHEREAS, The Air Land Emergency Resource Team (ALERT) has  
2 rendered invaluable aid to countless individuals during times of  
3 crisis; and

4           WHEREAS, ALERT is a training and service organization  
5 dedicated to providing disaster relief, search and rescue  
6 operations, and humanitarian aid at the request of public  
7 officials; and

8           WHEREAS, The members of this outstanding group have completed  
9 an intensive 14-month training program located at the International  
10 ALERT Academy in the Piney Woods of Texas; there, they learn a  
11 variety of rescue skills, ranging from land search and water  
12 recovery to structural fire fighting and crime scene evidence  
13 searches, all of which prepare them to be of assistance in an  
14 emergency; and

15           WHEREAS, Since its inception, ALERT men have answered the  
16 call to serve in several countries and more than 20 states; their  
17 efforts have included responding to tornadoes, floods, mud slides,  
18 and hurricanes, including Katrina and Rita, as well as conducting  
19 wilderness searches for lost people and downed aircraft, assisting  
20 officials with city improvements, and providing leadership at  
21 children's camps; and

22           WHEREAS, The men of ALERT exemplify high ideals of character  
23 and service, and their important work truly makes a difference in  
24 the lives of countless people; now, therefore, be it
