1 WHEREAS, Daniel Flores is celebrating his retirement as
2 carpenter shop foreman from the physical plant department at Sul
3 Ross State University after 29 years of employment; and

4 WHEREAS, The son of Roberto and Elisa B. Flores, Daniel
5 Flores graduated from Alpine High School and attended Sul Ross
6 State University; and

7 WHEREAS, After helping to build railroad bridges and to lay
8 electrical line from El Paso to Del Rio, Mr. Flores joined the staff
9 of the Sul Ross physical plant department in 1977; and

10 WHEREAS, Initially employed on the grounds watering crew, Mr.
11 Flores arranged large pipes around campus to water the lawns in the
12 days before the underground sprinkler system was installed; and

13 WHEREAS, Transferring to the carpenter shop in 1980, he
14 worked as a maintenance man until he was promoted to the job of
15 carpenter in 1987; and

16 WHEREAS, He was named foreman of the shop in 1992, and since
17 that time, he has built cabinets, bookshelves, vanities, and
18 partition walls across campus; in addition to remodeling offices
19 and classrooms and repairing many doors, windows, floors, and
20 roofs, he has also helped to build the sand volleyball court, the
21 tennis court shack, and restrooms at the softball field; and

22 WHEREAS, Throughout a period of expansion at Sul Ross, Daniel
23 Flores has served the university long and well; his skilled
24 handiwork is literally evident in nearly every corner of the

1 campus, and his high standards of excellence and dedication to the
2 welfare of the university community have earned him the lasting
3 gratitude of all who know him; now, therefore, be it

4 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 80th Texas
5 Legislature hereby congratulate Daniel Flores on his retirement
6 from Sul Ross State University and extend to him best wishes for
7 continued happiness; and, be it further
