1 WHEREAS, Victor Ramon has received a 2007 Texas Christian
2 University Texas Youth Entrepreneur of the Year Award in honor of
3 his innovative ideas and enterprising spirit; and

4 WHEREAS, The TCU youth entrepreneur program gives
5 scholarships to students currently enrolled in high school who have
6 excelled at starting and managing a business; Mr. Ramon was
7 recognized for the two successful businesses he has founded while a
8 student at Highland Park High School; and

9 WHEREAS, In 2002, Mr. Ramon started Highland Park Computer
10 Repair; four years later, that venture is flourishing and he is in
11 the process of becoming certified by Microsoft as a desktop support
12 technician; and

13 WHEREAS, At the beginning of the 2006-2007 school year, he
14 also founded HP Tutors in order to help other students succeed in
15 difficult high school courses; his company, which pairs struggling
16 students with the school's top achievers, already has a team of 15
17 tutors and an expanding list of satisfied clients; and

18 WHEREAS, A gifted and highly motivated young Texan, Victor
19 Ramon is vice president of the student congress and a member of the
20 National Honor Society, Spanish National Honor Society, and Science
21 National Honor Society; he has also attained the rank of Eagle
22 Scout; and

23 WHEREAS, Mr. Ramon was presented with his award, a \$1,000
24 scholarship, at a banquet held on February 12, 2007, at TCU; and

1 WHEREAS, Endowed with an ability to perceive a consumer need
2 and marshal the resources to fill it, Victor Ramon has rendered a
3 genuine service to his fellow students and to his community while
4 demonstrating an abundance of initiative, organizational skill,
5 and perseverance--qualities that clearly portend a bright and
6 rewarding future; now, therefore, be it
