1 WHEREAS, The City of Irving is hosting the 10th Anniversary
2 Transportation Summit on August 7-10, 2007; and

3 WHEREAS, Since the first event, the summit has evolved into a
4 nationally and internationally known conference; this year's
5 symposium will bring together public policy leaders at all levels
6 to commemorate past advances and look to future needs, including
7 multimodal transportation investment; elected officials and
8 transportation experts will serve as keynote speakers on topics
9 that reflect the summit's theme, "The Future Starts Here"; and

10 WHEREAS, Coordinated by the City of Irving and Dean
11 International, Inc., and sponsored by a list of noteworthy public
12 and private entities, the 10th anniversary event is expected to be
13 the largest summit yet, with some 1,200 people attending and
14 numerous cities and counties also taking part; and

17 the City of Irving in support of this significant issue merit
