R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, With the passing of Robert Vance Payne on March 1,
2 2007, the people of Center have lost a beloved community leader, and
3 we join them in mourning their loss; and

4 WHEREAS, Born on August 13, 1941, in Shreveport, Louisiana,
5 Mr. Payne graduated from Center High School in 1959 and from Stephen
6 F. Austin State University in 1963; and

7 WHEREAS, For many years, Mr. Payne helped to run his family's
8 business, Payne-Payne Hardware 'n Suchlike, which operated in
9 downtown Center from 1915 until 1996; he also oversaw *Payne's*
10 *Community News*, founded by his parents in 1949, and served as the
11 announcer for many years for the Center Roughrider football games;

13 WHEREAS, This active and valued resident of East Texas was a
14 past president of both the Shelby County Chamber of Commerce and the
15 Southwest Hardware and Implement Association; a member of the
16 Center Noon Lions Club, he also participated in the 2007 class of
17 Leadership Shelby County; and

18 WHEREAS, Mr. Payne cherished his faith and was a lifelong
19 congregant of First United Methodist Church of Center, where he
20 served in a number of leadership capacities and participated in the
21 Chancel Choir for more than four decades; and

22 WHEREAS, Above all else, he was devoted to his wife, Billie
23 Sue, his children, Angela, Rob, and Joshua, and his grandchildren,
24 Jennifer, Hannah, and Hunter; and

1 WHEREAS, Although his death has brought great sorrow to those
2 who loved him, Vance Payne has left behind many fond memories that
3 friends and family will forever treasure; now, therefore, be it

4 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 80th Texas
5 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life of Robert Vance Payne and
6 extend deepest sympathy to the members of his family: to his wife,
7 Billie Sue Payne; to his daughter, Angela Walker, and her husband,
