1 WHEREAS, Texas singer Jason "Sundance" Head has performed
2 memorably on the popular television talent competition, *American*
3 *Idol*; and

4 WHEREAS, Born and raised in Porter, Sundance Head is the son
5 of R&B singer Roy Head, who had three top 40 hits in 1965 and whose
6 hit "Treat Her Right" reached number two on the Billboard pop chart
7 that year; and

8 WHEREAS, Growing up in a house with a gold record hanging on
9 the wall, Sundance Head was inspired to follow in his father's
10 footsteps; a singer from an early age, Mr. Head also plays guitar,
11 bass, and piano and composes songs; and

12 WHEREAS, Mr. Head surprised and greatly impressed the judges,
13 even Simon Cowell, by confidently performing the blues standard
14 "Stormy Monday" at his audition in Memphis; he continued to impress
15 the judges with what one journalist called a "smoking" rendition of
16 "Mustang Sally" and made it into the Top 16 contestants on the show;

18 WHEREAS, At only 28 years of age, Sundance Head has had an
19 extraordinary year; his good fortune includes his appearance on
20 *American Idol* as well as his marriage and the birth of his first
21 child, Levi Aron Head; and

22 WHEREAS, Sundance Head has won the hearts of millions of
23 television viewers nationwide, and his talent, drive, and
24 enthusiasm surely herald a bright future; now, therefore, be it
