

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Participants in Leadership Southeast Texas are
2 celebrating the 15th anniversary of the founding of their notable
3 organization and are traveling to Austin on March 26, 2007, for
4 Leadership Southeast Texas Day at the State Capitol; and

5 WHEREAS, Organized by the Partnership of Southeast Texas,
6 Leadership Southeast Texas is designed to provide business and
7 civic leaders with opportunities to learn about and contribute to
8 area economic advancement; and

9 WHEREAS, Leadership Southeast Texas promotes a better
10 understanding of both the obstacles to and the opportunities for
11 economic development, regional unity, and quality of life in
12 Southeast Texas; including representatives from Chambers, Hardin,
13 Jasper, Jefferson, Liberty, Newton, Orange, and Tyler Counties, as
14 well as the Bolivar Peninsula of Galveston County, LSET identifies
15 and studies issues that are significant to ongoing business
16 development and encourages innovative approaches to addressing the
17 issues; and

18 WHEREAS, The program boasts more than 650 graduates who
19 represent 120 businesses, organizations, and governmental entities
20 from the region and includes some alumni who now live and work in 20
21 different states, Europe, and the Middle East, in addition to
22 nearly 50 different Texas cities; and

23 WHEREAS, Communities are increasingly affected by national
24 and international forces, and they are often on the front lines of

1 change, but events and needs may be too great for one city or county
2 to address alone and instead require regional and statewide
3 efforts; for Southeast Texas to continue to grow and thrive, it is
4 imperative that communities appreciate their interdependence and
5 work together to succeed; and

6 WHEREAS, Building networks of civic-minded individuals with
7 exceptional understanding of economic issues, Leadership Southeast
8 Texas has contributed immeasurably to the success and prosperity of
9 the region and the Lone Star State, and it is most appropriate to
10 commend this noteworthy program; now, therefore, be it

11 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 80th Texas
12 Legislature hereby recognize March 26, 2007, as Leadership
13 Southeast Texas Day at the State Capitol and extend to LSET alumni
14 and new graduates sincere best wishes for continued success; and,
