4 candy-store manager C. T. Heisig; sharing the candy-store location 5 on Park Street, the company's equipment originally consisted of one 6 foot-powered machine and two wooden tubs for washing bottles; and

7 WHEREAS, Purchased by Charles V. Rainwater in 1911, the 8 Beaumont franchise quickly grew and moved twice to accommodate the 9 needs of its growing customer base; the business operated out of a 10 plant on Mariposa Street for 54 years until it moved to its 11 present-day facility on the Eastex Freeway in 1985; and

12 WHEREAS, Today, the Beaumont company continues to benefit the 13 business climate in Southeast Texas, making deliveries of over six 14 million cases of beverages annually to more than 5,000 retail 15 customers in eight counties and employing some 200 area residents; 16 and

WHEREAS, For 100 years, the Beaumont Coca-Cola Bottling Company has contributed significantly to the Texas economy, and all those associated with the company are to be commended for their efforts in behalf of this long-standing Lone Star business; now, therefore, be it
