R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Eric Baemayr of Boy Scouts of America Troop No. 511
2 in Austin has attained the rank of Eagle Scout, and this
3 accomplishment truly merits special recognition; and

4 WHEREAS, Receiving the Eagle Scout badge is a significant
5 honor, bestowed on only a small fraction of those who enter the
6 scouting movement; in the course of meeting the rank's demanding
7 criteria, Mr. Baemayr earned the requisite 21 merit badges and
8 successfully completed an Eagle Scout project in which he collected
9 shoes for patients at the Austin State Hospital; this enterprising
10 scout far surpassed his initial target of collecting 500 pairs of
11 shoes and ultimately donated more than 1,000 pairs; and

13 Scout rank since he first joined the scouts, Eric Baemayr attained
14 his goal while coping with the challenges posed by a serious medical
15 condition that has required him to undergo several open-heart

17 range of scouting activities and has demonstrated outstanding
18 leadership ability, winning the respect and admiration of his
19 fellow scouts; and

20 WHEREAS, Eagle Scout Baemayr's dedication to excellence and
21 his perseverance in the pursuit of his goals have proven him worthy
22 to stand among scouting's elite, and he may indeed reflect with
23 pride on a job well done; now, therefore, be it
