R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Texas A&M University--Corpus Christi is graduating
2 17 distinguished nursing students from its College of Nursing and
3 Health Sciences in May 2007; and

4 WHEREAS, After years of hard work and dedication, these fine
5 Texans have earned their bachelor of science degrees in nursing;

7 WHEREAS, The administrators and faculty of A&M--Corpus
8 Christi and the school's graduating nurses are committed to
