

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The House of Representatives of the State of Texas
2 is pleased to recognize Texas Chiropractic College in Pasadena for
3 its long history and its many contributions to chiropractic
4 education in this state; and

5 WHEREAS, Texas Chiropractic College was founded in San
6 Antonio in 1908 and relocated to Pasadena in 1965; the college is
7 accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools and
8 the Council on Chiropractic Education; and

9 WHEREAS, Each year, the college confers approximately 115
10 doctor of chiropractic degrees and 20 bachelor of science degrees;
11 as of 2006, alumni of Texas Chiropractic College numbered 3,500,
12 located primarily in Texas and the Southwest; and

13 WHEREAS, Currently, the doctor of chiropractic program has
14 350 students and the undergraduate program has 60 students; the
15 school's faculty-led research explores facets of nutrition, pain
16 management, spinal manipulation, diabetes, and alternative
17 therapies; and

18 WHEREAS, Moody Health Center, the college's outpatient care
19 facility, is a model integrative health care facility that features
20 traditional chiropractic care and family practice by medical
21 doctors; the facility also offers acupuncture, massage, and dietary
22 management and has about 3,500 patient visits yearly; and

23 WHEREAS, Texas Chiropractic College is the fourth-oldest
24 chiropractic college in the world, and it is recognized as one of

1 the best; now, therefore, be it

2 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 80th Texas
3 Legislature hereby commend Texas Chiropractic College for
4 providing 99 years of outstanding chiropractic education and extend
5 to all associated with the college best wishes in all their future
6 endeavors; and, be it further

7 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be
8 prepared for the college as an expression of high regard by the
9 Texas House of Representatives.
