1           WHEREAS, Judge William C. Morrow of Midland retired as board  
2 member of the Commission on Jail Standards on January 31, 2007, the  
3 same day he retired as county judge of Midland County; and

4           WHEREAS, Created in 1975 by the Texas Legislature, the  
5 Commission on Jail Standards establishes policies and procedures  
6 governing the construction, equipment, maintenance, and operation  
7 of jail facilities, as well as the custody, care, and treatment of  
8 inmates and the programs aimed toward them; and

9           WHEREAS, A graduate of Baylor University, Judge Morrow was  
10 appointed to the commission by Governor Rick Perry on September 27,  
11 2002; during his tenure, he worked to promote safe and suitable  
12 Texas county jails through the enforcement of reasonable and humane  
13 minimum standards; and

14           WHEREAS, Judge Morrow served the State of Texas with  
15 dedication and integrity, earning the lasting respect of all who  
16 were privileged to work with him, and it is indeed fitting to honor  
17 him as he embarks on this new chapter of his life; now, therefore,  
18 be it

19           RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 80th Texas  
20 Legislature hereby commend Judge William C. Morrow on the occasion  
21 of his retirement as board member of the Commission on Jail  
22 Standards and as Midland County judge and extend to him sincere best
