14 Hixon, Dr. Crisp married Elodia Luna; a devoted husband and father,  
15 he takes great pride in his family, which today includes four  
16 children, two stepchildren, 11 grandchildren, and two

18 profession are pediatric neurologist Dr. Darrell Crisp and  
19 pediatric radiologist Dr. Mathew Crisp; and
