19 she is a member of the West Oaks School of Music and the Kempner High
20 School Orchestra and has played with the Polytechnic High School
21 Orchestra in Long Beach, California; she aspires to attend the
22 University of Houston to study music theory and composition, as
23 well as business management, and she hopes to one day own her own
24 music school and business; and

2 pride to her family and teachers, and it is a pleasure to recognize
3 Tajah Burton as an exemplary member of the community whose many
4 achievements foretell a bright future; now, therefore, be it
