17 competitions, and his involvement with the Apollo Choir earned him

19 WHEREAS, In addition to his interest in music, Mr. Johnson is
20 a community volunteer who is active in Higher Dimensions, Bible
21 study, the YMCA, Men of Excellence, the Boys and Girls Club, and
22 more; he plans to attend college and major in international
23 marketing and hopes to one day have a career involving music and
24 youth; and

2 pride to his family and teachers, and it is a pleasure to recognize
3 Brandon Johnson as an exemplary member of the community whose many
4 achievements foretell a bright future; now, therefore, be it
