18 participates in the March of Faith Drill Team and goes caroling
19 every year at a local nursing home; he hopes to attend Southern
20 University in Baton Rouge and practice law to help the less
21 fortunate; and

23 pride to his family and teachers, and it is a pleasure to recognize
24 Charles Young as an exemplary member of the community whose many
