2 citizen, Jairus Francis is being recognized at the Reginald Keith  
3 Guillory Scholarship/Academic Awards Luncheon on April 14, 2007;

17 Could" and special recognition at the South Central Chapter 21st  
18 Regional Conference; and

19           WHEREAS, He is currently chaplain of the National Youth  
20 Achievers and has volunteered with the Socks for Senior Citizens  
21 Program at the Anna Dupree Terrace Retirement Homes, Share Your  
22 Christmas and Walk-It-Out at Loyal Missionary Baptist Church, and  
23 the First Ward Activity Club; he aspires to become a mechanical  
24 engineer, sports agent, or football player and to be a positive

2 WHEREAS, This fine young Texan is a source of tremendous  
3 pride to his family and teachers, and it is a pleasure to recognize  
4 Jairus Francis as an exemplary member of the community whose many
