1 WHEREAS, The North Texas Chapter of the International Code
2 Council has received an International Code Council Chapter Merit
3 Award in recognition of its commitment to building safety and fire
4 prevention; and

5 WHEREAS, The International Code Council develops the codes
6 used to construct residential and commercial buildings, including
7 homes and schools, that are commonly adopted by U.S. cities,
8 counties, and states; and

9 WHEREAS, Representing some 500 members from more than 130
10 municipal jurisdictions and 40 industries, the North Texas Chapter
11 of the International Code Council provides a forum in which members
12 can stay current on building safety industry news, network with
13 colleagues, and engage in training opportunities; the chapter's
14 receipt of a merit award specifically acknowledges its work with
15 the North Texas Council of Governments to ensure consistent code
16 adoption and to monitor legislation relating to building and
17 construction; and

18 WHEREAS, Thanks in part to the dedicated efforts of the
19 International Code Council, the United States enjoys some of the
20 highest standards of building safety in the world, and the North
21 Texas Chapter contributes immeasurably to the protection of
