2 Galveston Housing Authority, is ending one chapter of her life and
3 beginning another with her retirement at the end of May 2007; and

4 WHEREAS, The Galveston Housing Authority oversees nearly
5 1,000 units of federally subsidized housing, a rental assistance
6 program, and several programs promoting home ownership; and

7 WHEREAS, In her 10 years directing the housing authority, Ms.
8 Strain has been instrumental in revitalizing the public housing
9 system in Galveston; taking charge of the organization during a
10 challenging time in its history, she successfully worked to restore
11 the authority's "high performer" rating with the U.S. Department of
12 Housing and Urban Development; and

13 WHEREAS, Ms. Strain's superb management skills have been
14 matched by her genuine compassion for the residents of public
15 housing; not only has she worked to ensure housing for Galveston's
16 neediest and most vulnerable citizens, she has also been a leader in
17 the effort to help low-income and middle-income residents buy their
18 own homes; and

19 WHEREAS, Sharon Strain may indeed reflect with pride on her
20 innovative leadership, which has helped to ensure a brighter future
21 for countless area Texans; now, therefore, be it
