

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Governor Bill Richardson of New Mexico has earned
2 the Sembrador del Bien Award from the Sin Fronteras Organizing
3 Project for his notable efforts to promote justice and positive
4 change in his community; and

5 WHEREAS, Bill Richardson has dedicated his life to the public
6 good as a United States congressman, ambassador to the United
7 Nations, United States secretary of energy, and now governor of New
8 Mexico; and

9 WHEREAS, Mr. Richardson began his career as a public servant
10 as the U.S. representative for New Mexico's 3rd Congressional
11 District; his many accomplishments during his 15 years of service
12 in this position include bringing new industry to the state,
13 helping to create the Jemez National Recreation Area and protect
14 the Rio Grande and the San Juan Basin, and successfully winning the
15 release of hostages, military personnel, and prisoners in North
16 Korea, Iraq, Cuba, and Sudan; and

17 WHEREAS, Nominated to represent the United States at the
18 United Nations by President Bill Clinton in 1997, Ambassador
19 Richardson worked to promote universal human rights and democracy,
20 to improve the status of women in foreign lands, and to stop the
21 spread of international terrorism and the proliferation of
22 biological weapons; and

23 WHEREAS, Unanimously confirmed by the United States Senate as
24 secretary of energy in 1998, Secretary Richardson was a champion

1 for clean and renewable technologies, for environmental
2 responsibility, and for reducing the nation's dependence on foreign
3 sources of oil; he was the first secretary of energy to request the
4 congress to provide compensation for Department of Energy workers
5 whose health had been affected by working in nuclear power plants;
6 and

7 WHEREAS, In his role as governor, Bill Richardson has
8 garnered support across party lines by improving education, cutting
9 taxes, expanding access to health care, helping to develop
10 renewable energy, and building a stronger economy for the people of
11 New Mexico; and

12 WHEREAS, Governor Richardson has further served his state and
13 nation as chairman of the Western Governors' Association and the
14 Border Governors' Conference, as chairman of Freedom House, a
15 nonpartisan organization promoting democracy worldwide, and as a
16 member of the boards of the Natural Resources Defense Council and
17 United Way International; for his work freeing hostages and
18 prisoners around the world, he has been nominated four times for the
19 Nobel Peace Prize; and

20 WHEREAS, The strength of our communities depends on the
21 commitment and dedication of leaders who, like Bill Richardson, use
22 their considerable talents to benefit others; now, therefore, be it

23 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 80th Texas
24 Legislature hereby congratulate Governor Bill Richardson of New
25 Mexico on winning the Sembrador del Bien Award from the Sin
26 Fronteras Organizing Project and extend best wishes to him for
27 continued success; and, be it further
