R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, Fermin Dorado has earned the Sembrador del Bien  
2 Award from the Sin Fronteras Organizing Project for his notable  
3 efforts to promote justice and positive change in his community;

5           WHEREAS, A native of El Paso, Mr. Dorado earned his  
6 automotive mechanic certification from El Paso Technical School  
7 before serving his country as a member of the U.S. Army; discharged  
8 from the military in 1967, he used the GI Bill to attend The  
9 University of Texas at El Paso, where he earned bachelor's and  
10 master's degrees in civil engineering; and

11           WHEREAS, Mr. Dorado went on to enjoy a distinguished career  
12 as the city engineer for the City of El Paso, during which he  
13 managed numerous major construction projects, including health  
14 clinics, branch libraries, fire stations, community centers,  
15 parks, and athletic fields, as well as improvements to public  
16 works; in addition, he developed a city ordinance to ensure the  
17 process for selecting engineers and architects to design city  
18 projects would provide equal opportunities, and it has since opened  
19 the doors to many who were previously denied access; and

20           WHEREAS, Now president of Dorado Engineering, Inc., Mr.  
21 Dorado has long supported his hometown through his involvement with  
22 such noteworthy organizations as the United Way of El Paso County,  
23 the Boy Scouts of America, and Centro Medico del Valle; moreover, he  
24 has served as president of the Fiesta de las Flores Hispanic

1 Cultural Center and of LULAC Council No. 132; and

2 WHEREAS, The strength of our communities depends on the  
3 commitment and dedication of leaders who, like Fermin Dorado, use  
4 their considerable talents to benefit others; now, therefore, be it
