18 school student at Kashmere Senior High School, where she is on the  
19 honor roll, a peer tutor, and an active member of the Student  
20 Council, KHS Book Club, and KHS Leadership Team; her community

22 Baptist Church and the Citizen, Housing, and Motivation Program;
