1 WHEREAS, Dr. Jose Manuel de la Rosa has earned the Lucy G.  
2 Acosta Humanitarian Award, presented by LULAC Project Amistad; and

3 WHEREAS, For nearly a decade Dr. de la Rosa served as regional  
4 dean of the Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center School of  
5 Medicine in El Paso, also directing the branch as lead academic  
6 officer and CEO; he previously worked in the department of  
7 pediatrics as an instructor, assistant professor, and associate  
8 professor; and

9 WHEREAS, Dr. de la Rosa has further given of his time and  
10 expertise to benefit his community, helping to establish the  
11 Kellogg Community Partnership Clinics, four school-based health  
12 centers that provide services to colonia residents in El Paso's  
13 lower valley; appointed to serve on the Border Health Commission by  
14 President Bush, he has also advocated for his fellow West Texans  
15 through testimony before interim committees of the state  
16 legislature; and

17 WHEREAS, A charter member of the National Hispanic Medical  
18 Association and the Hispanic-Serving Health Professions Schools,  
19 Dr. de la Rosa is also active with the Foundation for the Diocese of  
20 El Paso; and

22 service to which all may aspire, and his efforts in behalf of his  
23 community have made a positive difference in the lives of many; now,
