R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The family and friends of *Ciro Leonel Trevino* of  
2 *Edinburg* sustained an immeasurable loss with his passing on March  
3 20, 2007, at the age of 53; and

4 WHEREAS, Born on October 18, 1953, in *Edinburg* to *Ciro*  
5 *Trevino* and *Antonia Anzaldua Trevino*, Mr. *Trevino* attended *Sacred*  
6 *Heart Catholic School*, *Edinburg High School*, and *The University of*  
7 *Texas--Pan American*, where he was a member of *Phi Kappa Theta*  
8 *Fraternity* and *Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia*; in keeping with his love of  
9 music, he earned a bachelor's degree in that discipline and a  
10 master's degree in secondary supervision; and

11 WHEREAS, Mr. *Trevino's* 30-year tenure as a band director was  
12 the fulfillment of his lifelong ambition; after graduating from  
13 college, he embarked on his career as an assistant band director in  
14 the *Mercedes Independent School District*; he was subsequently hired  
15 by *Edinburg High School* as an associate band director, and he later  
16 served his alma mater as head band director; he spent the final four  
17 years of his tenure with the district as the school's director of  
18 fine arts before retiring in June 2006; and

19 WHEREAS, A member of the *Texas Music Educators and Band*  
20 *Masters Associations*, he enjoyed the respect of his peers and also  
21 won the admiration of many of his students with his genuine  
22 commitment to their welfare and his ever-present good humor, and  
23 numerous young people were inspired to pursue careers in music as a  
24 result of his positive example; and

1           WHEREAS, In addition to attaining professional success, Mr.  
2 Trevino enjoyed a rewarding marriage with his wife of 30 years,  
3 Leticia Montalvo Trevino, and together they were blessed with three  
4 children, Robert, Aaron, and Amanda; and

5           WHEREAS, Although his death has brought great sorrow to his  
6 loved ones, Ciro Trevino lived a caring and purposeful life, and he  
7 leaves behind a legacy to treasure for those who held him dear; now,  
8 therefore, be it

9           RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 80th Texas  
10 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life of Ciro Leonel Trevino  
11 and extend sincere sympathy to the members of his family: to his  
12 wife, Leticia; to his sons, Robert Daniel Trevino and Aaron Andrew  
13 Trevino; to his daughter, Amanda Yvette Trevino; to his father,  
14 Ciro Trevino; and to his other relatives and many friends; and, be
