## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The members of Christ United Methodist Church in Farmers Branch are observing the 50th anniversary of the church's founding during 2007 with special events throughout the year; and

WHEREAS, The church traces its roots back to the fall of 1956, when a small group of area residents initiated steps to establish a house of worship in this rapidly growing region of Dallas County; on January 6, 1957, 44 people attended the church's first service, which was held at Valwood Elementary School, and by Easter Sunday, the number of charter members had grown to 135; and
