WHEREAS, Judge Everingham began his career in 1993 as a law clerk to U.S. District Judge Howell Cobb, then also a member of the bench for the Eastern District; after a year, Judge Everingham joined the Longview firm of Brown McCarroll & Oaks Hartline as an associate attorney; he served as lead counsel in complex jury trials and as second chair counsel in numerous other cases, representing clients in both state and federal courts; and

WHEREAS, An alumnus of Stephen F. Austin State University,
