15 Laundry and Cleaning for some 35 years; she successfully balanced

17 beloved daughter; and

18 WHEREAS, A resident of Mineola since 1993, Mrs. Goss today
19 embraces the freedom of living in her own home with minimal
20 assistance and only recently gave up driving; a woman of abiding
21 faith, she keeps up with friends from her Rebekah Lodge membership
22 of 50-plus years, likes to watch game shows and church programs on
23 television, and enjoys the love and affection of her many
24 grandchildren and great-grandchildren; and

1 WHEREAS, This delightful centenarian attributes her
2 longevity to genetics and to her steadfast spiritual beliefs; she
3 maintains a positive outlook and an enthusiasm for each new day that
4 are an inspiration to all who know her; now, therefore, be it
