

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The Honorable Glenn H. Kothmann served as the voice
2 of the citizens of Bexar County for more than a quarter-century, and
3 he may indeed reflect with justifiable pride on his lifetime of
4 achievement; and

5 WHEREAS, A native of the Lone Star State, Senator Kothmann
6 was born in San Antonio and attended Texas A&M University, where he
7 was a member of the meat and livestock judging teams; also a student
8 of the Command and General Staff College, he attained the rank of
9 corporal as a sophomore, sergeant major as a junior, and executive
10 officer of the infantry regiment as a senior, later retiring as a
11 major general; and

12 WHEREAS, This notable public servant went on to serve five
13 terms in the Texas House of Representatives and five terms in the
14 Texas Senate; and

15 WHEREAS, During his extensive legislative career, Senator
16 Kothmann shared his considerable experience with a number of
17 committees, helping to lead the Natural Resources, State Affairs,
18 Commerce and Industry, Municipal and Private Corporations, and
19 Public Lands and Buildings Committees as vice chair and the State
20 Affairs Subcommittee on Elections, Natural Resources Subcommittee
21 on Energy, and Security at San Antonio State Hospital Committee as
22 chair; moreover, he was elected by his fellow senators to serve as
23 president pro tempore during the 64th Legislative Session; and

24 WHEREAS, Outside of the political arena, Senator Kothmann

1 enjoyed a varied career in the real estate and financial
2 industries; and

3 WHEREAS, His considerable contributions to his state and
4 country earned him a number of honors, most notably the U.S.
5 Distinguished Service Medal and the Lone Star Distinguished Service
6 Medal; and

7 WHEREAS, Throughout his life, Glenn Kothmann has
8 demonstrated an exemplary commitment to his state and nation, and
9 his dedicated service truly deserves special commendation; now,
10 therefore, be it

11 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 80th Texas
12 Legislature hereby recognize the Honorable Glenn H. Kothmann for
13 his many achievements and extend to him sincere best wishes for the
14 future; and, be it further

15 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be
16 prepared for Senator Kothmann as an expression of high regard by the
17 Texas House of Representatives.
