1 WHEREAS, Lorena Aguilar of Houston is one of the exceptional
2 participants in the 27th annual Texas History Day art competition,
3 and her entry is among those being displayed at the Bob Bullock
4 Texas State History Museum on April 27-28, 2007; and

5 WHEREAS, This talented artist is also a first round finalist
6 in the Culture Shapers Visual Art Contest, and she took part in the
7 Coca-Cola Art of Harmony competition and has contributed to a quilt
8 created in memory of the heroes of September 11th; her career focus
9 is advertising and design; and

10 WHEREAS, Texas History Day is coordinated by the Texas State
11 Historical Association and is an affiliate of the National History
12 Day program, which designated "Triumph and Tragedy" as the theme
13 for 2007; more than 20,000 Texas students in grades six through 12
14 participate in Texas History Day activities, and about 60 of those
15 students will go on to represent the Lone Star State at the National
16 History Day event in Washington, D.C.; and

17 WHEREAS, Ms. Aguilar is a senior at Barbara Jordan High
18 School for Careers; she is ranked 13th out of 292 students in her
19 class and is a member of the National Honor Society; among her other
20 many accomplishments, she maintains a perfect attendance record;

23 commendable, and she merits special recognition for her
24 accomplishments; now, therefore, be it
