1 WHEREAS, Deerpark Middle School of the Round Rock Independent
2 School District has achieved notable success during the 2006-2007
3 school year; and

4 WHEREAS, The winner of the Texas Education Agency Gold
5 Performance Acknowledgment for three consecutive years, Deerpark
6 has earned the 2006 Level II Commitment Award from The University of
7 Texas at Austin Center for Performance Excellence and was recently
8 named one of the Hundred Best Public Schools in Texas by *Texas*
9 *Monthly* magazine; and

10 WHEREAS, This outstanding campus has participated in the
11 Texas Education Agency's Adolescent Literacy Project, conducted by
12 The University of Texas at Austin Vaughn Gross Center for Reading
13 and Language Arts; moreover, as a Gateway to Technology pilot
14 school, Deerpark is the only middle school in Central Texas to offer
15 a combined math, science, engineering, and shop program that
16 enables students to earn high school credit; and

17 WHEREAS, Talented young Texans who attend the institution
18 have become state and national finalists in the Duke University
19 Talent Identification Program, while the seventh grade Academic UIL
20 team was named third place district sweepstakes winner and four
21 students earned Awards of Excellence in the National Parent Teacher
22 Association's Reflections contest; and

23 WHEREAS, Students have also excelled in extracurricular
24 activities, with the seventh grade basketball team named district

1 champions and the orchestra named sweepstakes winner in the North
2 Area Austin UIL orchestra concert and sight reading competition;

5 all students achieve their full potential, and their professional
6 successes have earned them a number of honors; in the past year, art
7 teachers from the institution have been selected as presenters at
8 the Texas Art Education Association Conference and National Art

12 2007 are a great honor for the school and merit special recognition;
